Pranav and Curtis,

I do not support the removal of the existing TTC bus stop location at Neilson Road and Oakmeadow Blvd. (north intersection).

I have been working with members of our community for over a year for the installation of a traffic control signal at this location, as the intersection is highly utilized.

The removal of the TTC bus stop would negatively impact access to public transit, specifically the 133 TTC route vehicles. The community is composed of a high number of seniors and young families who require convenient access to public transit to accommodate their daily lives. Removing the stop would have a negative impact on the residents in particular seniors. At a time when the City is promoting public transit usage, removing a well-utilized location is not beneficial to anyone.

As mentioned in your email, I am hosting a community meeting to discuss a traffic light installation on Thursday, January 26, with the Transportation Services staff.

To reiterate, I do not support the removal of the bus stop location and would like confirmation it will remain in place.
